MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Master's degree in urban planning, geography, public administration, architecture, civil engineering, environmental science, or related field, and one year professional planning experience; or any equivalent combination of related training and experience. Successful completion of a criminal history background investigation is required prior to employment. Applicants within six months of meeting the education/experience requirement may be considered for trainee status.

Positions assigned to the Department of Environmental Protection: A valid Florida Driver License is required and a Motor Vehicle Record that meets the requirements of Alachua County policy # 6-7; Motor Vehicle Records will be reviewed prior to employment. If in the past 24-month period, the record shows more than 3 moving traffic violations, and/or a conviction/pending charge for driving under the influence, the minimum qualifications are not met for the position.

This position is a professional position to manage EPD's water conservation program and implementation of the county wide water quality code; including the general requirements, erosion and sediment control, stormwater, fertilizer, Florida Friendly Landscaping, and irrigation elements. The selected candidate will supervise 2-4 employees and will be responsible for assisting with budgeting, hiring, and purchasing processes. This position requires experience with developing, implementing, and enforcing environmental codes. Training through the Florida Association of Codes Enforcement (or equivalent) and experience with citations, Codes Enforcement Boards, and/or a Special Magistrate process is preferred. Experience with irrigation systems and landscaping professionals would benefit this position. This position may assist with obtaining and managing grant funded projects. Excellent written and oral communication skills desirable.
