### General Statement of Job

The Principal / Public Works Engineer performs highly professional, administrative, and technical engineering work. The position is responsible for management of Capital Projects including those designated with LAP funds. These projects include but are not limited to the following disciplines: roadway, traffic safety, resurfacing, sidewalk, trail, landscaping and hardscaping, stormwater, lighting, pond rehabilitation, widening and utilities. The Principal/Public Works Engineer plans, coordinates, and reviews City infrastructure projects consistent with the City's Complete Streets policy while also reviewing private subdivision, site, and building plans for code conformance. Work is performed under the general direction of the Public Works Director.

### Minimum Qualifications

Bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering or related field and eight (8) years responsible engineering experience to include two (2) years of supervisory experience. Any equivalent combination of education, experience and training may be substituted for minimum requirements.

Possession of a valid Professional Engineering (P.E.) license issued by the State of Florida and a valid Florida Driver's License.

Must show proof of FDOT LAP courses taken within the last 3 years.

Must have or be able to complete FEMA ICS-100 (Intro to the Incident Command System) and ICS-700 (National Incident Management System) courses within six (6) months of hire.
