This position acts as the primary liaison with local transit providers including bus and rail transit, represents the TPO at various meetings and engages in public outreach as needed to seek input on transportation plans and studies. Applicants must be adept at building strong professional relationships, have a keen eye for detail and the ability to manage projects from concept to completion.

The R2CTPO office is located in beautiful Daytona Beach, Florida within a short drive to world famous attractions, including the Daytona International Speedway, Kennedy Space Center and Central Florida theme parks. We serve a population of just over 600,000 people residing in Volusia County and the eastern portion of Flagler County.
